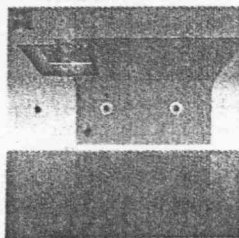

## Lothar Götz LONDON

The painter and decorator of the art world Lothar Götz is known for transforming rooms into rainbow worlds of sumptuous colour. Bands of red, pink, blue and yellow are applied to the walls with rollers and the results look something like a Duhux paint swatch. It was a romantic enthusiasm for modernist architecture that first excited this German artist into making

his creations, using the paint to highlight small idiosyncrasies and imperfections in the buildings he inhabited. Since then he has decorated an entire flat marked for demolition in Liverpool and recently coloured the walls of a space in Wharf Road, London, for a group show ruminating on the word love. This special commission for the



Chisenhale will be his most ambitious project to date and will see the artist converting white walls into bold and beautiful colour. **JESSICA LACK**
